

Sunshine Water Services requested a change in local water and wastewater rates. Our request was reviewed by the Florida Public Service Commission and a final decision has been issued for new rates across our service area, to be effective after issuing the attached notice.

Increasing rates is a difficult decision. We make every effort to keep operating costs to a reasonable minimum while maintaining critical infrastructure for public health, everyday needs, and during severe weather conditions. This necessary rate adjustment supports:

- continued safe and reliable service
- necessary infrastructure improvements; and
- continued compliance with federal, state, and local environmental regulations.

Utilities are an integral component of our country's critical utility infrastructure. Since our last rate case in 2020, the company has invested approximately \$104 million in our water and wastewater systems, which provide essential services needed every day. Our ability to ensure safe and reliable water and wastewater service to both our residential and commercial customers must be maintained to protect public health.

## **Rate Change Timeline**

The rates shall be effective for service rendered as of the Commission's stamped approval date on the tariff sheets provided the customers have received notice. If the effective date of the new rates falls within a regular billing cycle, the initial bills at the new rate may be prorated. The old rates shall be prorated based on the number of days in the billing cycle before the effective date of the new rates. The new rates shall be prorated based on the number of days in the billing cycle on or after the effective date of the new rates.

**Meter Installation Charge:** The Commission also approved an increase in the meter installation charge to \$591.83 for a 5/8"x 3/4" water meter, which is the standard size of a residential water meter. This change reflects that all future water meters will be compatible with its Advanced Metering infrastructure.

**Miscellaneous Service Charges:** While the miscellaneous service charges did not change, the Commission ordered the terminology to change consistent with Commission Rules. Thus the previous initial connection and disconnection charges are obsolete and now subsumed into the premises visit charge which is \$40.06 during normal business hours and \$49.62 after hours.
